112 is the phone number to call emergency services throughout the EU, from fixed or mobile phones, free of charge, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

You can reach the European emergency number 112 in all Member States of the European Union as well as in Croatia, Faroe Islands, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco,

Norway, Turkey, Switzerland and Vatican.
